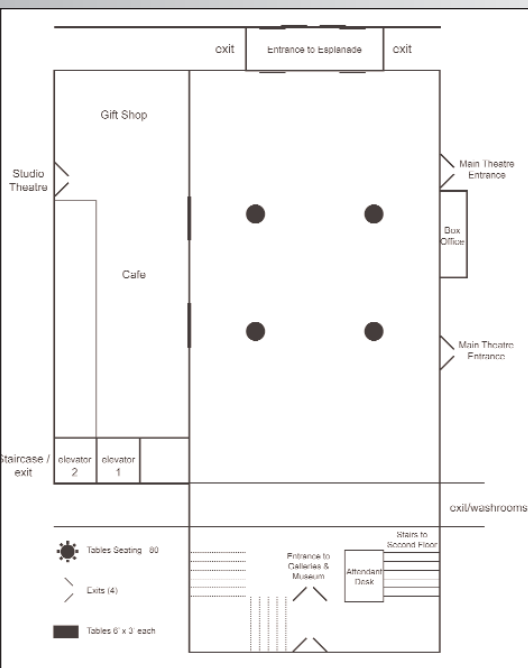

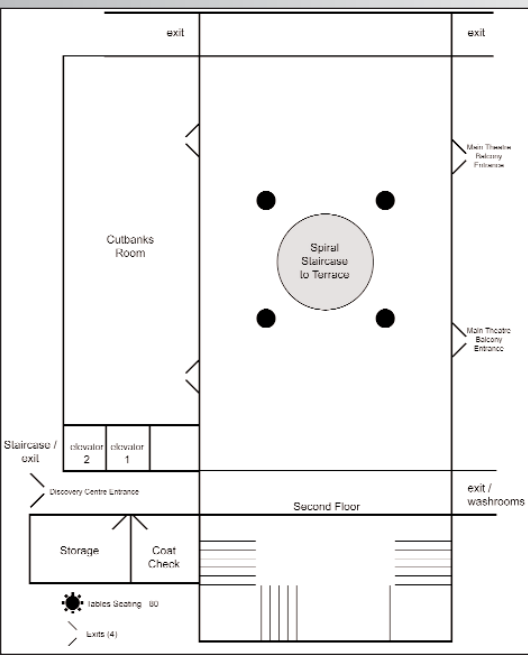

Alicia began her early education in Irvine, Alberta and graduated from Eagle Butte High School in 1998. Alicia was the president for the student council and involved in many sporting activities. She began her post secondary education at the Lethbridge Community College where she played on the women's volleyball team and graduated with her diploma in Agriculture. Alicia furthered her education and obtained a degree in Range Management at the University of Saskatchewan and graduated with distinction in 2002.

In 2005, Alicia along with her brother James took over managing the JH Ranch and Alicia became very involved in minimizing the impact of gas well development on native prairie grasslands and the flora and fauna that thrived there. Alicia loved the outdoors and the ranching life. She was contracted by the Saskatchewan Government and worked diligently to complete a series of field guides for the Saskatchewan Forage Council.

Her traveling bug was inherited from her late parents, Harry and Anthea and became one of Alicia's great passions. Africa, Mexico, Thailand, Greece and New Zealand were a few of the special places she visited in her lifetime, as well as the numerous trips made to Australia to visit family. Other activities Alicia enjoyed included photography, painting, music and sports.
